

**FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT
INVESTIGATIVE REPORT**

On Monday, July 26, 2021, Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Special Agent (SA) received a call from Javier Manjarres (hereafter, referred to as Manjarres), where he alleged that he had documentation on Richard Lee DeNapoli (hereafter, referred to as DeNapoli), where he voted twice in two (2) different counties, in 2014.

SA Haberland contacted Broward County Assistant State Attorney (ASA) Chris Killoran, Supervisor of the Public Corruption Unit. ASA Killoran stated he had spoken to Kevin Tynan (hereafter, referred to as Tynan), who called him regarding this same complaint and informed him the statute of limitations would have expired.

SA Haberland confirmed with FDLE Regional Legal Advisor, Jackie Boswell, the statute of limitations had expired.

Tynan nor Manjarres, have provided information on the second allegation to SA Haberland or ASA Killoran.

Manjarres was notified the statute of limitations had expired.
