On March 1, 2021 at approximately 2200 hours while eastbound on route 60 at Carter Gallier Blvd, I saw a Jeep Wrangler make a U-turn ahead of my location and began traveling the same direction as I was. The vehicle moved over to the right lane and immediately began swerving back and forth, crossing both lines numerous times. I conducted a traffic stop on route 60 at the county line, and made contact with the driver Cameron Francis. I told him why I stopped him and he said he had been playing with his phone. I saw that his eyes were extremely red and I detected an odor of alcoholic beverage coming from his person. I asked him if he'd been drinking, he told me he had earlier in the day but nothing recent. I asked him how much and he told me two beers. While waiting for him to retrieve his registration, I shined my light in his backseat floorboard and saw an open beer sitting in the cupholder, which was located in the center of the vehicle just behind the

driver and passenger seat. I asked him about the beer and he said he drank it earlier but wasn't drinking it now.

I conducted SFST's where Francis displayed clues of impairment. I offered the PBT where he agreed to provide a sample. The result was .139 BAC. I placed him under arrest for DUI 1st offense and drinking while driving, handcuffed him, and placed him in the backseat of my patrol car. Once at PSO, he agreed to provide a sample in the Intox EC/IR II. The result was .13 BAC.

Francis' vehicle was towed and stored by Fred's Towing. The bodycam of the SFST's is attached to this report as well as a photo of the open beer in the cupholder. Francis received an unsecured bond and was released.
