## Narratives

### Original Narrative

07/22/2020 05:08:41

On 07/22/2020, i was dispatched to Sheetz located at \_\_\_\_\_ Anderson Highway for a larceny. Upon my arrival i spoke to manager, Tia Johnson. She stated that a white male entered the store and went to the men's bathroom and dropped a book bag that he brought into the store. She stated that at approximately 02:20 hours he then went into the beer cooler and retrieved three 42 ounce Icehouse Edge beers and exited the cooler. On his way back towards the bathroom he grabbed a bag of beef jerky. The suspect then went back into the bathroom and exited with his book bag and then exited the store. The suspect then came back into the store with no bookbag and purchased \$5.30 worth of tobacco. The suspect then exited the store, got into a red Jeep \_\_\_\_\_ that display VA license plate, RVA \_\_\_\_\_ and exited the parking lot heading East on Anderson Highway. I observed this whole incident on the stores Surveillance footage. The suspect was a white male, mid twenties, wearing a black jacket, black shorts and a baseball cap. Johnson stated that the same male has stolen items from the store before and due to that reason they wanted to go forward with charging the suspect if located.

I ran the suspect's license plate using my mobile date computer. The plate came back to an older white male that resides at \_\_\_\_\_ Scottwood Road in Midlothian. I contacted Chesterfield Police Department and requested a CPD unit respond with me to the Scottwood Road address in an attempt to identify the suspect. Upon my arrival at the residence i observed the suspect vehicle parked in the driveway. At the front door i made contact with 24 year old Cameron Francis. I advised him that i knew he had stolen some beer from the Sheetz in Powhatan. When asked, Cameron stated that he still had the beer inside of his residence. He then allowed me to come inside of the residence where he walked me down to his bedroom. Once in the bedroom, Cameron retrieved a black book bag from his closet. He then removed three 42 ounce beers from the bookbag as well as a bag of Jack Links beef jerky. All of the items were taken from Sheetz without being purchased. Cameron stated that he has an alcohol problem and does not have money to purchase the alcohol he needs.

Cameron was issued a summons for petit larceny first offense. I retrieved the three beers and beef jerky. The three beers were still cold to the touch and sealed. The bag of beef jerky was opened. I transported the recovered items to Sheetz and turned them back over to Tia Johnson. I requested surveillance footage of the incident from management.
